

The Stonewall Uprising

On June 28, 1969 NYPD violently raided Stonewall, an LGBTQ+ bar, culminating in the community fighting back. The uprising stretched over six days. It was not the first time police raided a gay bar, and it was not the first time LGBTQ+ people fought back, but the events at Stonewall fundamentally changed the discourse surrounding LGBTQ+ activism. While Stonewall became well known due to media coverage and the subsequent annual Pride traditions, it was a culmination of years of LGBTQ+ activism. For us, Pride has usually been seen as a celebration with Queer joy being resistance. Pride is our collective struggle against the criminalization of LGBTQQIA+ existence. In this current climate, we stand firm in our fight for our trans and non-binary friends' and family members' liberation.

The first Pride march in New York City was held on June 28, 1970 on the one-year anniversary of the Stonewall Uprising. The concept behind the initial Pride march was formally proposed by lesbian activist Ellen Broidy, who had written the proposal together with Craig Rodwell. E.R.C.H.O. (Eastern Regional Conference of Homophile Organizations) had been organizing an annual July 4th demonstration (1965-1969) known as the "Reminder Day Pickets," at Independence Hall in Philadelphia. At the E.R.C.H.O Conference in November 1969, the 13 homophile organizations in attendance voted to pass a resolution to organize a National annual demonstration, to be called Christopher Street Liberation Day.








PARKING/TRANSPORTATION

There is free parking at the 69th Street Shoppers lot, but it is a 7 minute walk to the festival. As a result, we encourage attendees to park locally, use rideshare, or take public transit. SEPTA 101 & 102 trolleys, 110, 111, and the 115 from 69th Street Terminal will be running.

The Delaware County Pride Festival and all related Pride events are Smoke-Free! Smoking and vaping will not permitted on festival grounds or at any of the related U.D.T.J. Pride events.

Please make sure to get your tickets! Volunteers and security will be stationed at each entrance to assist you. There may be protesters present and we ask all attendees to refrain from interacting with them. If you see something, say something to Pride Central or our Security tent.



The Delaware County Pride Festival is excited to welcome everyone for our inaugural year. Below you can find some additional information that may be helpful to those attending the festival.

- Make sure to grab Pride merchandise and gear from Pride Central.
- We ask all festival attendees to please enter through the main entrances and reserve a ticket.
- ♦ All children should be accompanied an adult.
- ♦ Festival volunteers and staff can be easily identified with purple shirts if you need assistance.
- ♦ It is recommended that attendees bring cash to tip the drag performers.
- **♦ The Pride events are rain or shine.**
- ♦ There will likely be protesters, BUT do not interact with them and notify our security staff.
- ♦ There will be UDPD officers on the perimeter of the festival, but will not be walking through the festival.
- ♦ There will be volunteer security staff and a police liaison at the security tent for the public.


