Violence Prevention & De-escalation Training: Violence has impacted our youth and marginalized communities on many levels. We will prioritize conflict resolution, anger management, restorative justice approaches, crisis intervention support, and trauma-responsive approaches.

Diversionary Programs: The beauty of creative arts and expression are important to self-discovery and empowerment. From visual to audio, to writing and speaking, we will have something for our youth to excel in and enjoy!

Mentorship & Internships: Our mentorship and internship programs will provide opportunities for individuals to assist with center operations, conducting activities and cohorts, and fostering leadership and personal growth within the community. This will extend into advocating for marginalized youth's needs, and empowering participants to navigate challenges and pursue long-term goals.

Educational Series: Education is a cornerstone of empowerment. In collaboration with Upper Darby, William Penn, and Southeast Delco school districts, we are facilitating an 8-part opioid educational series. Educational series focusing on vaping, de-escalation training, violence prevention, and financial & digital literacy are soon to come!
